AFI 32-6004, 5 May 1994, is supplemented as follows:

2.1.1. Within Air Education and Training Command (AETC), unaccompanied officer personnel housing and unaccompanied enlisted personnel housing will be equipped with furniture constructed of a minimum of five plywood products. Lodging quarters (visiting officer quarters (VOQ), visiting airmen quarters (VAQ), and temporary lodging facilities (TLF) will be equipped with the type selected by the AETC interior design staff.

2.5. An aggressive program should be established to refinish and repair existing ranch oak furniture in lieu of replacement.

4.3. Use AETC Form 300, **Furniture and Equipment Issue/Turn-in Request**, to record issue and turn-in actions.

4.4. Nonprior service student dormitory occupants are excluded from the requirement to have a signed AF Form 228, **Furnishings Custody Receipt and Condition Report**.

4.5. Report serviceable excess items to HQ AETC/CEPH prior to issuing for administrative use.

4.7. (Added) Form Prescribed. AETC Form 300.
