Airman convicted of substance abuse

A senior airman from the 81st Medical Support Squadron pled guilty at a special court-martial for huffing compressed air multiple times (in violation of Article 92, UCMJ); possessing and using spice on multiple occasions (in violation of Article 92, UCMJ); disobeying a lawful order issued by a senior NCO (in violation of Article 92, UCMJ); making two false official statements (in violation of Article 107, UCMJ); and using another Airman's post office box to procure an intoxicating substance (in violation of Article 134, UCMJ). The military judge sentenced him to be reduced to E-1, confined for three months and discharged from the service with a bad conduct discharge.

81 TRW ARTICLE 15S

- An airman basic from the 334th Training Squadron was punished for violating a general order prohibiting consumption of alcohol while under the age of 21, in violation of Article 92, UCMJ. The Airman received a forfeiture of \$715.00 for one month, restriction to Keesler Air Force Base for 60 days and a reprimand.
- A senior airman from the 81st Comptroller Squadron was punished for failing to return from lunch in a timely manner, in violation of Article 92, UCMJ. This was the most recent incident of misconduct in a series of incidents which were previously administratively documented. The Airman received a suspended reduction to airman 1st class and a reprimand.
- An airman 1st class from the 366th TRS was punished for violating a general order prohibiting consumption of alcohol while under the age of 21, in violation of Article 92, UCMJ. The Airman received restriction to the limits of Naval Construction Battalion Center - Gulfport, Mississippi for 30 days and a reprimand.
- An airman 1st class from the Det 2, 366th TRS was punished for willfully granting an unpermitted individual access to the dormitory, in violation of Article 92, UCMJ. The Airman received a reduction to the grade of airman and a reprimand.
