Court-Martial

- An airman first class from the 81st Medical Support Squadron pled guilty at a Special Court-Martial for failing to obey a lawful order issued by a member of the 81st Security Forces Squadron, in violation of Article 92, UCMJ; operating a vehicle while drunk, in violation of Article 111, UCMJ; stealing from the Base Exchange on divers occasions, in violation of Article 121, UCMJ; and being drunk and disorderly, in violation of Article 134, UCMJ. A military judge sentenced the Airman to be reduced to airman basic, forfeit \$1,000 pay per month for two months, confined for 60 days and punitively discharged from the Air Force with a bad conduct discharge.

Nonjudicial-Punishments

Alcohol/Drug Related Incidents

- An airman first class from the 336th Training Squadron was punished for consuming alcohol while in the training dormitories, in violation of Article 92, UCMJ. The Airman received forfeitures of \$461, restriction to the limits of Keesler for 14 days and a reprimand.
- An airman basic from the 336th TRS was punished for consuming alcohol while in the training dormitories, in violation of Article 92, UCMJ and for making a false official statement, in violation of Article 107, UCMJ. The Airman received forfeitures of \$391, restriction to the limits of Keesler for 14 days and a reprimand.

Alcohol/Drug Related Incidents

- An airman first class from the 336th TRS was punished for possessing alcohol while in the training dormitories, in violation of Article 92, UCMJ. The Airman received forfeitures of \$615 pay per month for two months, restriction to the limits of Keesler for 30 days and a reprimand.
- An Airman from the 336th TRS was punished for possessing alcohol while in the training dormitories, in violation of Article 92, UCMJ. The Airman received forfeitures of \$439, restriction to the limits of Keesler for 14 days and a reprimand.

Miscellaneous Misconduct

- An airman from the 336th TRS was punished for being disrespectful to an NCO, in violation of Article 91, UCMJ. The Airman received forfeitures of \$300 and a reprimand.
- An airman first class from the 338th TRS was punished for engaging in intimate behavior and being behind closed doors in the dormitory belonging to a member of the opposite sex, in violation of Article 92, UCMJ. The Airman received a reduction to the grade of airman, suspended for six months, extra duties for 14 days and a reprimand.
- An airman first class from the 338th TRS was punished for engaging in intimate behavior and having a member of the opposite sex behind closed doors in their dormitory, in violation of Article 92, UCMJ. The Airman received a reduction to the grade of airman, suspended for six months, extra duties for 14 days and a reprimand.
- A senior airman from the 81st Diagnostic and Therapeutics Squadron was punished for dereliction of duty, in violation of Article 92, UCMJ. The Airman received forfeitures of \$1,133 pay per month for two months, suspended for six months and a reprimand.
- A staff sergeant from the 81st MDTS was punished for failing to properly maintain a government purchase card and failing to obey a lawful order, both in violation of Article 92, UCMJ. The sergeant was reduced to the grade of senior airman, forfeitures of \$1,241 pay per month for two months, suspended for six months and a reprimand.
