PRESIDIO OF MONTEREY AIRMAN FIRST CLASS CONVICTED OF ABUSIVE SEXUAL CONTACT

An airman first class assigned to the 311 Training Squadron, Presidio of Monterey, Calif., was found guilty by officer members at a special court-martial of abusive sexual contact for groping the breast of another airman while she was asleep (in violation of Article 120, UCMJ). The sentence, as approved by the convening authority, was reduction to the grade of airman basic, forfeiture of \$773 pay per month for six months and restriction to quarters for two months.

SHEPPARD AIRMAN CONVICTED OF ATTEMPTED DRUG USE AND FALSE OFFICIAL STATEMENT

An airman assigned to 361 TRS, Sheppard Air Force Base, TX pled guilty at a summary court-martial to attempted use of ecstasy for purchasing six capsules of the drug to use at a concert (in violation of Article 112a, UCMJ). Law enforcement apprehended her shortly after buying the drugs. She also pled guilty to signing a false official statement for lying about her pre-service drug use on her AF IMT 2030, *Use of Drug and Alcohol Abuse Certificate* (in violation of Article 107, UCMJ). The sentence, as approved by the convening authority, was reduction to airman basic, forfeiture of \$773 pay for one month, confinement for 3 days, restriction to Sheppard for 30 days and a reprimand.

81st Training Wing ARTICLE 15s

- An airman basic from the 335th TRS was punished for stealing from the base exchange, in violation of Article 121, UCMJ. The Airman received a forfeiture of \$700 pay and a reprimand.
- An airman from the 335th TRS was punished for sharing prescription medication with another airman, in violation of Article 112a, UCMJ. The airman received a reduction to airman basic, suspended forfeiture of \$867 and a reprimand.
- An airman basic from the 338th TRS was punished for leaving the airman's place of duty without permission, in violation of Article 86, UCMJ. The airman received a suspended forfeiture of \$773 and a reprimand.
- A senior airman from the 81st Diagnostic and Therapeutics Squadron was punished for disobeying an NCO and failing to obey a lawful order, violations of Articles 91 and 92, UCMJ. The airman received a suspended reduction to airman first class, 30 days extra duty and a reprimand.
- An airman first class from the 81st Medical Operations Squadron was punished for dereliction of duty and signing a false official statement, violations of Articles 92 and 107, UCMJ. The airman received a suspended reduction to airman, forfeitures of \$1,027 for two months with one month suspended, 10 days extra duty and a reprimand.
