### **Political Campaigns and Elections**

The political campaign season provides a number of unique issues for the DoD and military services. Below is a list of permitted and prohibited activities for active duty military members:

#### **Permitted Activities**

- Register, vote, and express personal opinions on political candidates and issues.
- Promote and encourage others to vote.
- Make monetary contributions to a political organization, party, or committee favoring a particular candidate or slate of candidates.
- Display a political bumper sticker on the member's private vehicle.

#### **Prohibited Activities**

- Wearing uniform at political events /elections or attend political events as official representative of the Armed Forces.
- Speak before a partisan political gathering.
- March or ride in a partisan political parade.
- Conduct fundraising activities in Federal facilities for any political cause or candidate.
- Display a large political sign, banner, or poster on a private vehicle.
- Commissioned officers shall not use contemptuous words against the President, the Vice President, Congress, the Secretary of Defense, the Secretary of a military department, the Secretary of Homeland Security, or the Governor or legislature of any state in which he or she is on duty.
