- College-bound students are required to complete four Carnegie units in Math for graduation, including Algebra I and Geometry. It is highly recommended that students take Algebra II and another course above the level of Algebra II during their high school career.
 - For enrollment in Pre-Algebra in the 7th grade, a student must score at or above a 70 NCE on a standardized/district math test, or in special circumstances, have the recommendation and approval of the 7th grade principal.
 - Pre-Algebra in grade 7 is a pre-requisite to take Algebra in grade 8.
 - For enrollment in Pre-Algebra in grade 8, a student must have a grade of 90 or higher in 7th grade math and score at or above 70 NCE on a standardized/district math test, or in special circumstances, have the recommendation and approval of the junior high school principal.
 - In order to enroll in Algebra I in grade 8, a student must (1) have a grade of 90 or higher in 7th grade Pre-Algebra or (2) have scored at or above a 90 NCE on a 7th grade standardized/district math test or (3) in special circumstances, have the recommendation and approval of the junior high school principal.

CHOIR- There is a cost to parents related to choral attire (tuxedo shirt, tie, cummerbund, and black pants/skirt).

BAND and STRINGS- Parents/Guardians should note that they are to provide the student's instrument.

- For enrollment in Pre-Algebra in grade 8, a student must have a grade of 90 or higher in 7th grade math and score at or above 70 NCE or receive a score of Advanced on a standardized/district math test, or in special circumstances, have the recommendation and approval of the junior high school principal.
- In order to enroll in Algebra I in grade 8, a student must (1) have a grade of 90 or higher in 7th grade Pre-Algebra or (2) have scored at or above a 90 NCE or receive a score of Advanced on a 7th grade standardized/district math test or (3) in special circumstances, have the recommendation and approval of the junior high principal.
- Eight grade students enrolled in Algebra I who pass the course with a grade of 70 or higher will receive one Carnegie unit of credit toward graduation.
- For future reference.... In order to enroll in 9th grade Geometry, a student must have a grade of 70 or higher in 8th grade Algebra I.

MATH

- College-bound students are required to complete four Carnegie units in Math for graduation, including Algebra I and Geometry. It is highly recommended that students take Algebra II and another course above the level of Algebra II.
- Pre-Algebra is a prerequisite for Algebra I at Biloxi Junior High School.
- In order to enroll in Algebra I in grade 9, a student must (1) have a grade of 90 or higher in 8th grade Pre-Algebra or (2) have scored at or above a 90 NCE on a standardized/district 8th grade math test or (3) in special circumstances, have the recommendation and approval of the junior high school principal.
- Students in grade 8 and 9 who do not qualify for Algebra I but have passed Pre-Algebra will be eligible to enroll in Transition to Algebra.
- In order to enroll in 9th grade Geometry, a student must have a grade of 70 or higher in 8th grade Algebra I.

SCIENCE- All students entering Grade 9 are tentatively scheduled for Science Skills and Reasoning. At the conclusion of this school year, students who have a grade of 90 or higher in 8th grade science will be scheduled for Biology I. Schedule confirmation forms will be sent home with the student at the end of the school year. Parents who desire a schedule change should contact the principal, 435-1421, for further instructions.

LIFESAVING - Students must be proficient in swimming skills as determined by the instructor to be eligible to enroll in Lifesaving.
