Mr. Miller is an instructor for the Basic Instructor Course (BIC) at the 81st Training Support Squadron, Keesler Air Force Base, Mississippi. As a BIC instructor, he trains and mentors the next generation of civilian and military instructors to build the nation's future warfighters.

Mr. Miller began his military career in August of 2000 when he enlisted into the Texas Army National Guard as a Multi-Channel Transmissions Systems Operator/Maintainer. During his 20 years of service, Mr. Miller supported numerous Defense Support of Civilian Authority (DSCA) missions and served one combat deployment in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom (OIF). He served in multiple roles throughout his career concluding in 2020 when he retired as the Brigade S-6 Non-Commissioned Officer in Charge (NCOIC) for the 72nd Infantry Brigade Combat Team (IBCT).

In February 2013, Mr. Miller began his teaching career at Angleton High School where he taught World Geography, Government, and Economics until 2019. After leaving Angleton, Mr. Miller began teaching at Gulfport High School where he taught World History until 2022. Prior to his current position, Mr. Miller began his civil service as an instructor for the RF Transmissions schoolhouse at 338th Training Squadron in 2022 where he taught the 3-level course as well as the Expeditionary Combat Support Radio (ECSR) course.
