Mr. Craig Edwards is the Instructor Supervisor of Continuation Training, Faculty Development (FAC-D) Flight, 81st Training Support Squadron, Keesler Air Force Base, Mississippi. Mr. Edwards is responsible for the day-to-day activities of five instructors and eight formal training courses, both online and in-residence. These training courses include: Technical Writer, Training Supervisor, Training Development, Instructor/Developer of Online Learning (IDOL), and the Application of Instructional Systems Development (AISD). Mr. Edwards has a direct impact on FAC-D's 1,250 annual course graduates.

Mr. Edwards joined the Department of Defense Civil Service in February 2016. He was initially assigned to the 336th Training Squadron, Keesler Air Force Base, Mississippi as a Cyberspace Systems Operations instructor. As an instructor in the Cyberspace Systems Operations course, he taught many concepts of computer and networking operations. His students learning about computer software installation and operations.
