GS-11 Susan A. Sabio is a Continuation Training Instructor, Faculty Development (FAC-D) Flight, 81st Training Support Squadron, Keesler Air Force Base, Missisippi. As an instructor in Faculty Development, she is qualified to teach the Instructor/Developer of Online Learning (IDOL) course of which prepares course developers and instructors to analyze and convert traditional training programs to the online or blended environment. Additional courses that Ms. Sabio instructs include: the Training Supervisor Course that provides training in the knowledge and skills needed to perform the duties of an instructor supervisor, Application of Instructional Systems Development (AISD) and the Technical Writer Course which trains personel in the knowledge and skills to conduct research, design, and develop student instructional materials for technical training.

Ms. Sabio entered the Air Force in August 1985. After graduating basic training, she continued to Chanute AFB, Illinois and completed the Aircraft Electrical Systems Specialist training in March 1986. Her first duty station was located at Blytheville, Arkansas where she worked as an aircraft electrician on B-52s and KC-135As in the 97 Field Maintenance Squadron. In October 1987, she was stationed at Upper Heyford, England where she worked in the 20 Component Repair



Squadron, Electro-environmental shop repairing parts from EF-111s. In January 1991, she cross-trained into the Communications-Computer Systems Control Specialist (Tech Controller) career field and was stationed in the 7th Communications Squadron at the Pentagon. In April 1993, Ms. Sabio moved to Tinker AFB, Oklahoma and worked in the 38 Engineering Installation Group quality testing newly programmed software. In May 1995, she moved over to the 72 Communications Squadron where she was the assistant NCOIC of the Help Desk section of the Base Network Control Center. In September 1996, Ms. Sabio completed an overseas short tour in the J6IS at Yongsan, Korea where she engineered, installed, troubleshot, and maintained the Global Command and Control System (GCCS) communications infrastructure. In October 1997, Ms. Sabio went back to Tinker AFB, Oklahoma to work in the 3d Combat Communications Support Squadron as a Systems Control Facility Evaluator. Her responsibilities included planning, coordinating and evaluating deployment training exercises for the four mission squadrons. In May 1999, she was stationed in the 314th Communications Squadron at Little Rock, Ark. as a Network Management Technician configuring Asynchronous Transfer Mode and Ethernet-based network infrastructures. Ms. Sabio originally became an instructor in the 333rd Training Squadron located at Keesler AFB, Miss. in July 2002 through April 2007. In May 2007, she retired from the Air Force after almost 22 years of service for her country. Prior to her current position, Ms. Sabio was an Application Intake Specialist for the Mississippi Regional Housing Authority VIII located at Gulfport, Mississippi.
