Technical Sergeant Jameson G. Pate, is the sole enlisted Basic Instructor Course Faculty Development Instructor (BIC) 81st Training Support Squadron, Keesler AFB, Mississippi. He manages the development of 250 newly assigned Technical Training Instructors. He ensures the production of over 25K trainees annually.

Sergeant Pate, completed Basic Military Training (BMT) in January 2011. He went on to complete 2M0X2 Missile and Space Systems Maintenance technical training where he graduated 25 April 2011 at Vandenberg AFB. While at F.E. Warren AFB working as a technician, he was promoted to Senior Airman Below the Zone, completed his first CCAF degree while working as Quality Assurance Evaluator (QA) & Wing Inspection Team (WIT), served in the F.E. Warren Base Honor guard (twice), received accolades for being key personnel on the Minuteman Simulated Electronic Launch (SELM) Team and assisted in the restoration of a flooded home for a gold star mother while attending Education & Training apprentice school. From here, Sgt Pate moved to Shaw AFB. Working as a Training Manager, he received his second CCAF degree while perusing his Bachelors of Applied Science (BAS) Energy Management degree at Bismarck State University. At the 20th Maintenance Group, he won two quarterly awards, as "Unit Training Manager of the Quarter", earned his subsequent five-skill level and shortly after, earned his subsequent seven skill-level. In 2018, Sgt Pate was selected to PCA to the 20th Communications Squadron (CS), where he was promoted to Technical Sergeant. In late 2018, he was picked up for a short-tour as the NCOIC, Maintenance Training Management at Kunsan AB. Upon his return to Shaw AFB in late 2019, Sgt Pate was selected to fill the position as Element Chief of training Management and held various positions within the MXG to bridge 3F2 manning issues. In Jul 2021 he was chosen to be the 9th AF 3F2 Functional and Unit Training Manager, 9th Airforce's Central Command (AFCENT) Shaw AFB, SC. Prior to his current position, Sgt Pate managed the development of newly minted 3F2 personnel. He ensured the readiness/wellbeing of 408 trainees annually and was the steward for \$3K of equipment. Sgt Pate and Paige Pate currently have 5 children and they are Mason, Hudson, Harrison, Olive and baby Piper who most recently arrived in August 2023.
