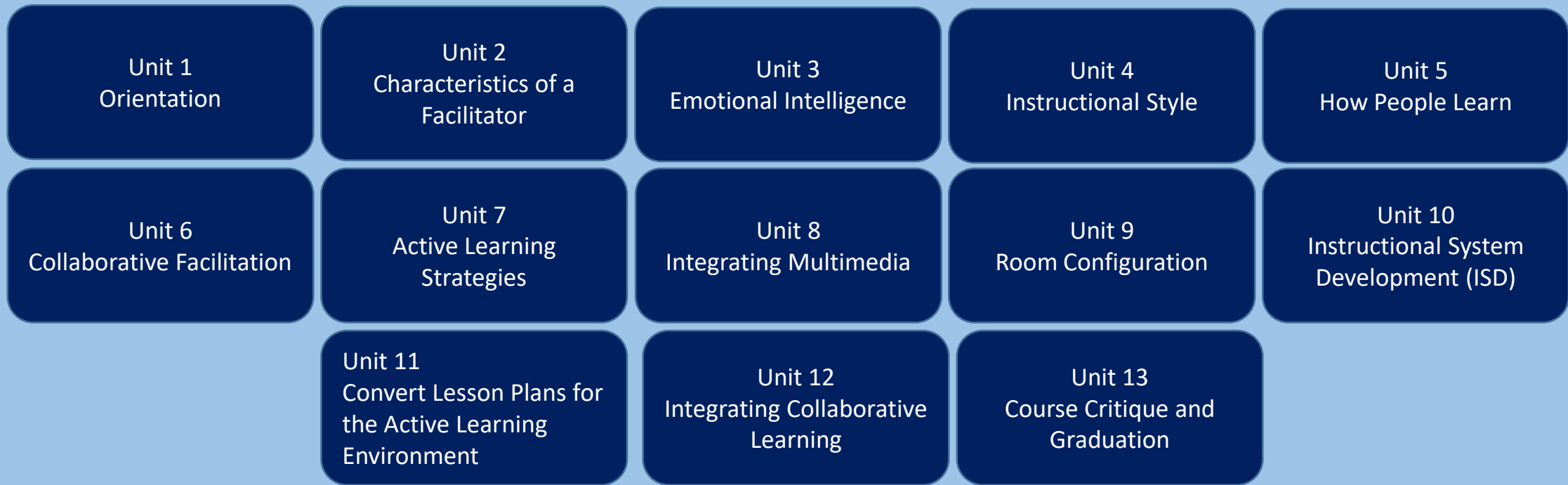
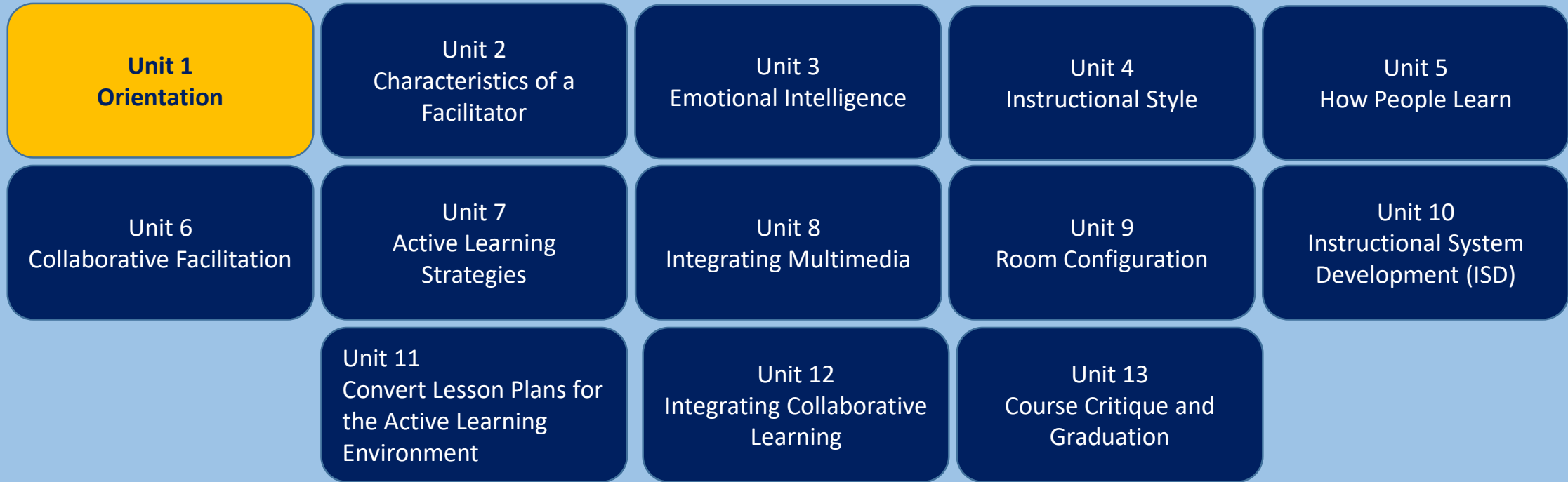


Enhanced Learning & Instructional Techniques Enrichment Course Map
